Dear Mr. Karno:

By this letter, please be advised that the Ledge Light Health District is thoroughly in support of the Town of Ledyard's efforts to secure grant funding through the small cities program of the Connecticut Department of Economic Development. We have been encouraged by the Town's pursuit of this funding in order to assist Ledyard homeowners to receive financial assistance to effect repairs to their on-site subsurface sewage disposal systems. We recognize that these funds might be applied to other worthwhile projects to improve private residences but feel that the ability to use such funding toward sewage system repair will greatly benefit homeowners as well as the Town of Ledyard, in general. Ledge Light has been working with the town and several homeowners for up to 2 years to effect repairs to severely failing and overflowing sewage systems. Availability of funds for these, or similarly effected homeowners, may finally allow the correction of such health hazards and nuisances which have been plaguing the homeowners, and other neighboring property owners, over this very long time. I have had the opportunity to work with contractors and property owners who have been faced with the cost of repairing their sewage systems and have come to know that there is a very real need for such assistance in the Town of Ledyard. I applaud your efforts.
