Project Title: Public Safety Radio _____ Program Area: AES Public Safety _____

Project Description: Currently the Fire Companies operate on what is referred to as low band VHF radio. Manufactures have general ceased to support this band. With no new pagers being produced and only a limited number of new radio's being produced the Public Safety Committee has designated a sub-committee to review the problem and suggest a solution. The probability is that a new radio system will be required. To prepare for this as the Administrator of Emergency Services I am anticipating a grant application in late calendar 2015 to facilitate the purchase. Lacking a successful grant application we would need to be preparing for this eventual expense.

This would fall under evaluation categories, DF, SR, and IOE

Planning Context: As this is a project under development the full context is yet to be fully detailed. Probable course is, develop plan and estimate thru Summer of 2015, grant application December 2015, Award notification Summer /Fall 2016 implementation Fall/Winter 2016.

Schedule: Earliest implementation would most likely be in FY 2016. If the project is not supported by grants then to amass the capitol required will take several additional years to complete.

Coordination: The timing of the new LECC could come into play if that project is significantly delayed.

Previous Town Meeting Action: None.

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Project Priority: Currently this has a medium priority due to the fact we are not at a crisis point. In fact this project is part of development to have a plan to avoid getting to such a point. (No new communications equipment available to purchase)

Estimated Cost: \$ 200,000 - Plan is to earmark 20k for two years, applying for a 80% grant. Actual total will depend on direction suggested and grant success.
