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Project Title: Rescue R-17 Repairs Program Area: Ledyard Fire Company

Project Description:

The requested funds will allow for the exterior repairs to Rescue R-17. The vehicle is a 1997 model year and is not slated for replacement until after 2020. Left in its current condition without making these repairs, the vehicle will further deteriorate, making repairs much more costly in the future.

Body rot caused by environmental / salt exposure over the years has eroded protective coatings/paint. Since coatings and paint no longer protect these areas, the aluminum body is rotting. The numerous areas of rot are in need of repair to prevent further decay and exposure of critical components inside of the vehicle to weather and salt.

This cost is from quotes received to strip, repair and apply new coatings to the vehicle. This will contribute to the Town being able to utilize this reliable vehicle well into the future.
